EDC Director Larry Clonts reported on property management for 200 North Main, Texas Theater, The Rock and Mi Swaco. In addition Clonts reported on tourism and the Texas Travel Fair.

Robert Riley reported the H.O.T. Committee does not want to start any new projects until the depot project has been completed. Riley asked, the council to keep this committee in place and to appoint a council member to it after the May election.

Rushing reported on water leaks and replacements of fire hydrants.

Rushing briefed the council on the problems with the North West lift station. He also discussed the need to budget rebuilds on the two lift stations that have not been redone in the next couple of years.

Sherry Palmer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 p.m. Robert Riley seconded the motion. The motion passed: 5 votes for, 0 votes against.
